Love - Our True Identity (Meeting Room)

The problem is where we go to find our answers: ourselves, the world, media, friends. Study of Selected Psalms (Sanctuary)

Giving a Reason for the Hope (Room 103 - lower level)

This class builds upon the evangelism class from the past quarter. That class addressed some of the obstacles and misconceptions regarding sharing the gospel with others and also looked at how conversations, particularly questions, can be used as an effective means to reach others with the good news. In this follow-up class we will explore how we can naturally give a reason for the hope within us by sensing open doors and employing our unique stories to engage others for the kingdom. We will also look at the reality that God has called all of us to be prepared to share but has supernaturally gifted some for this outreach ministry.

Defend, Discover, and Disciple (Room 201)
